MESSAGE FROM THE MANAGEMENT'S DESK

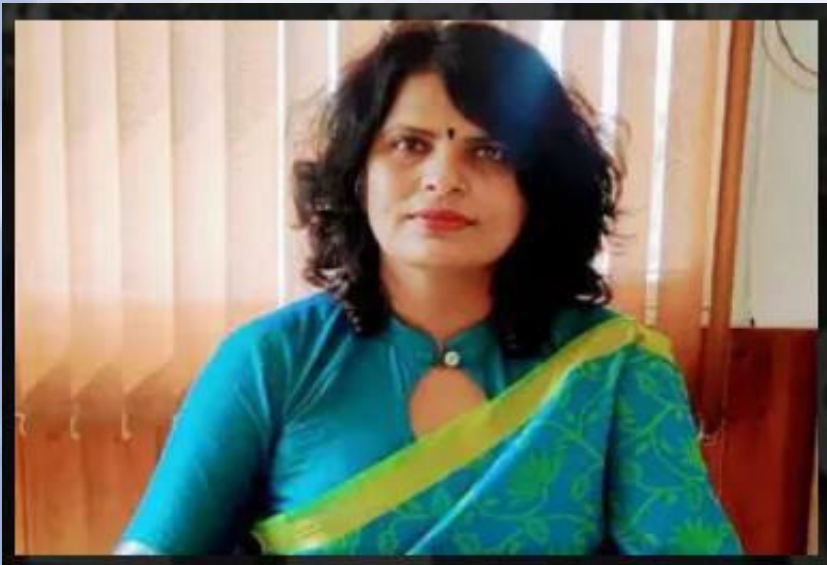

Class 10th Career Counselling Session



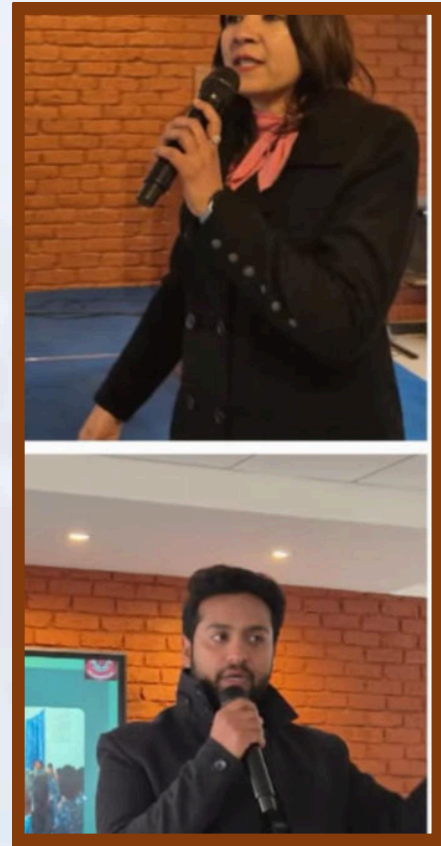
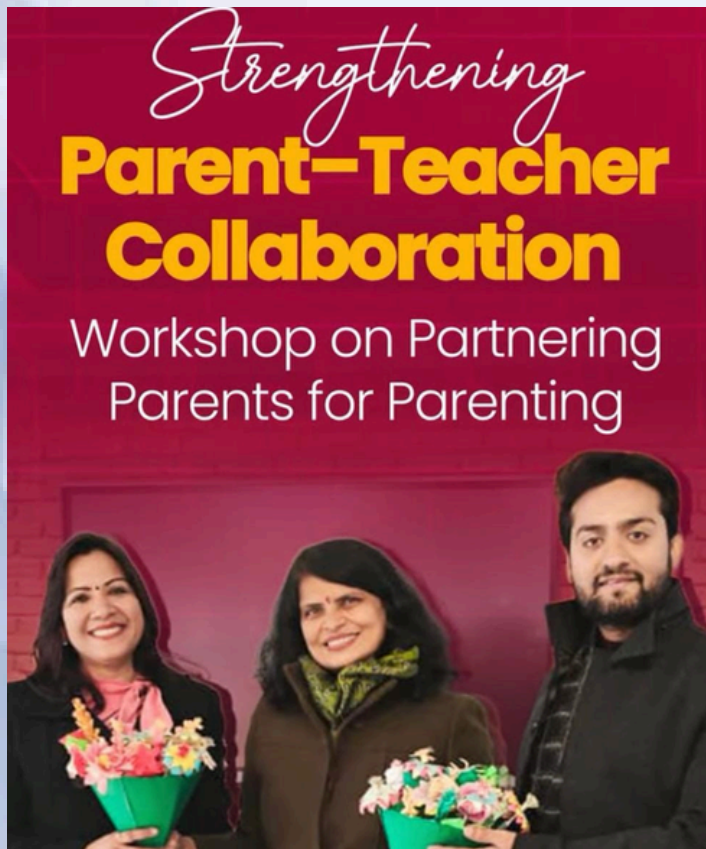

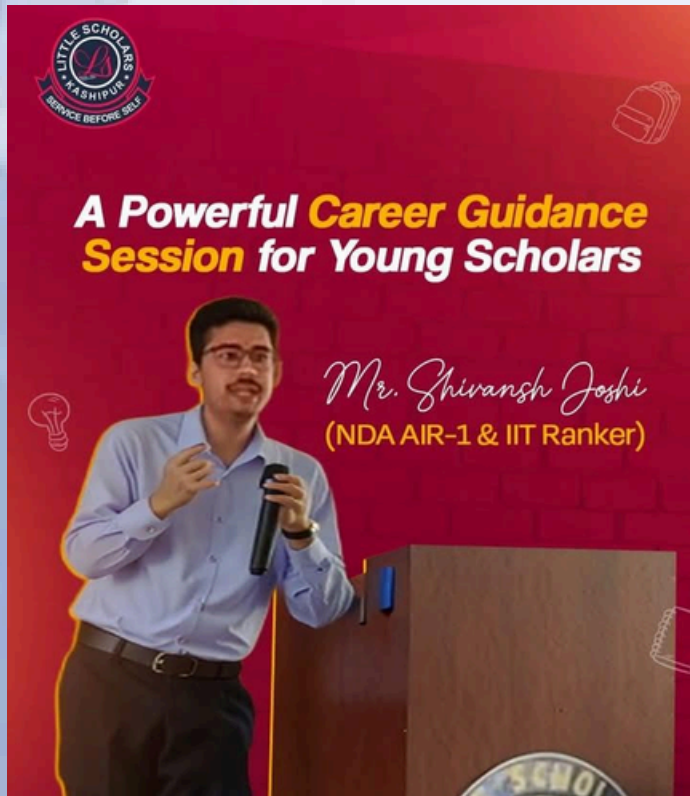
